Religion, Race, and Global Dallas Research Internship

The religion, race, and global Dallas research internship allows students to work within a specific East Dallas community through archival and oral research methods. Students will contribute to a larger book and documentary project that explores the history of ISCKON (International Society for Krishna Consciousness) movement in the heart of east Dallas. Previous work on the ISCKON movement has been largely limited to the east and west coasts, and its international presence. Yet, in one small pocket of Dallas beginning in the
